


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
Storage Capacities, Relationships, and Utilization



Unused Storage Ratio: Total Unused Capacity (910.359 GB) divided by Physical Storage Capacity (3,200.000 GB) and may not exceed 45%.



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Response Time - Throughput Curve

The Response Time-Throughput Curve illustrates the Average Response Time (milliseconds) and I/O Request Throughput at 100%, 95%, 90%, 80%, 50%, and 10% of the workload level used to generate the SPC-1 IOPSTM metric.
